**Heritage Walk to Humayun's Tomb** was organized on 20<sup>th</sup> April, 2018 for students of class *VI and VII*.

The **Heritage Walk** was conducted under the Heritage week activity.

The objective of the walk was to make the students aware about the rich heritage of India .

A group of 129 Students from grade VI and VII were escorted to **Humayun's Tomb** in three school buses left the school premises at 9:20 am reached the destination at 11:00 am .**The Humayun's tomb** (*maqbaera e Humayun*) which is the tomb of the Mughal Emperor Humayun . The tomb was commissioned by Humayun's first wife and chief consort, Empress Bega Begum. in 1569-70, and designed by Mirak Mirza Ghiyas, a Persian architect. It was the first garden-tomb on the Indian subcontinent, and is located in **Nizamuddin East**. It was also the first structure to use red sandstone at such a scale. The tomb was declared a UNESCO World Heritage Site in 1993.

The Students took 1 hr20 minutes' walk at the heritage site. Students boarded the buses at 12:20 pm to come back to the school and by 1:30 pm the students were back to school.



The young MBSian students explored each and every place with a very inquisitive mind. The Walk ended with a promise to value and preserve the rich heritage of India.
